SAUVIGNON BLANC 2005 Redwood Valley

The benchland soils of Redwood Valley produce a definitive Sauvignon Blanc featuring lots of ripe melons, lemon grass, kiwi and pineapple. This wine is produced in small batches and fermented with wild yeast. Try it with organic Caesar salads or Thai cuisine.

Alcohol: 13.9% by volume.

Total sulfite, naturally occurring: TTB analysis, 8 ppm.

CHARDONNAY 2006 Redwood Valley

Fermented on our vineyards' natural wild yeast, this aromatic wine shares scents of apricot and honeyed pears. A smooth vanilla-oak finish pairs well with creamy sauces for pasta primavera or free range chicken.

SYRAH 2005 Redwood Valley

Our estate bottled Syrah shines with a brilliant purple hue. Refined tannins are balanced with big jammy flavors of black plum, boysenberry and a bit of mocha. This rich, flavorful wine pairs well with organic meats and cheeses, as well as chocolate desserts.

PETITE SIRAH 2006 Redwood Valley

Fermented with wild yeast and aged in French oak barrels, this tasty Petite has a lush bouquet of butterscotch and caramel, as well as complex layers of black cherry, blueberry, fig and coffee. Elegant and powerful, this wine will cellar well for up to six years.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2004 Redwood Valley

This Cab displays loads of complex fruit such as cherry, currant and blackberry, enhanced by a moderate level of acidity. The result is an elegant wine with a long, lingering finish. Complements grilled meats or vegetables, and chocolate cake.
