NATURAL WHITE NV California

A great everyday food wine. A blend of Butte County Chenin Blanc and Mendocino Chardonnay results in a medium-bodied wine with crisp acid and melon and pear fruit. Perfect for a picnic or a soup and salad dinner. This excellent wine is a pleasure to both purse and palate.

SAUVIGNON BLANC 2006 Mendocino

This wine is a pleasing blend of fruit from Lake and Mendocino counties. Try it with goat cheese rolled in an endive leaf, topped with fresh minced herbs.

CHARDONNAY 2006 Mendocino

Light French oak and a buttery mouth complement wild caught salmon, savory vegetarian cuisine and platters of cheese and fruit.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2006 Mendocino

Black cherry aromas and plum fruit with a hint of mint on the finish. This wine is a blend of Cabernet grapes from Redwood Valley and Ukiah, and is aged on French oak. Sip it slowly with Fair Trade organic chocolate.

This wine is a blend of grapes from the 27-year-old Butow Vineyard and Frey Vineyards of Redwood Valley. Aged on French oak. Serve with a roast and scalloped potatoes.

SANGIOVESE 2005 Mendocino

Deep garnet color, well-balanced and mellow. A basket of mixed fruits: blackberry, boysenberry and raspberry. Grapes grown by Jake Fetzer at Masut Vineyards in Redwood Valley; and certified Biodynamic by Demeter. Sangiovese is the native grape of Tuscany, and is the classic companion to a rich pasta dish.

Enjoy this lush and full-bodied wine with Mediterranean cuisine or roasted vegetables drizzled with olive oil and parmesan.

PINOT NOIR 2006

Light and delicate, this Pinot Noir is a harmonious symphony of strawberries, mint and pomegranate. The fruit is a blend of Uncle Bob's 28 year old dry farmed vineyard and 11 year old vines from Frey's Potter Valley Vineyard. Harvested in Oct. 2006 and aged on French Oak. Complements fish, fowl, and fruit salads.

MERLOT 2006 Redwood Valley

The limited supply of fruit was harvested October 2005, and aged on French oak. Serve with lamb, wild rice and a fruit pie.
