NATURAL WHITE NV California

Pale golden straw color. Lemon custard and praline aromas follow through to a crisp, light-to-medium body of sweet citrus, kiwi, and honey nut flavors.

Finishes with a nice toasty pie dough and melon fade. A fun, easy-going white wine for chicken dishes or picnics.

SAUVIGNON BLANC 2007 Mendocino

The ultimate food-friendly wine. Tropical flavors of pineapple and passion fruit married with delicate French oak complement spicy ethnic cuisine. This wine is a pleasing blend of fruit from Lake and Mendocino counties. Try it with goat cheese rolled in an endive leaf, topped with fresh minced herbs.

CHARDONNAY 2007 Mendocino

Experience delicate scents of apple blossom, followed by flavors of pear and ripe apple. This delicious wine comes from five Redwood Valley and Ukiah Vineyards harvested in September 2007. Light French oak and a buttery mouth complement wild caught salmon, savory vegetarian cuisine and platters of cheese and fruit.

The bench land soils of Redwood Valley produce magnificent Zinfandels. Ours is a blend from five organic vineyards. Filled with tight blackberry and raspberry fruit. This wine is aged on French oak. Buen Provecho!

CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2007 Mendocino

Deep purple color. Black cherry, berry and herb aromas follow through on a round, supple entry to a dry-yet-fruity full body and topped with nutmeg notes. Finishes with a crisp, tongue coating dusty tannin fade. Slip it slowly with Fair Trade organic chocolate.

SYRAH 2007 North Coast

An opulent nose, fragrant with spice and toasty oak. Full-bodied, made in the Northern Rhone Valley style, with luscious plum and currant flavors. This wine is a blend of grapes from the 28-year-old Butow Vineyard and Frey Vineyards of Redwood Valley. Aged on French oak. Serve with a roast and scalloped potatoes.

SANGIOVESE 2006 Mendocino

Rich, ruby color. Aromas of smoked spiced nuts, dried lemon peel, piney herbs, pomegranate, and pink peppercorn. Well-balanced and mellow follow through on a soft, supple entry to a dry-yet-fruity full body with a rounded texture, good fruit, and lively acidity underneath. Finishes with chocolate and apple skin notes. Certified Biodynamic grapes grown by Jake Fetzer at Masut Vineyards in Redwood Valley. An entertaining red to pair with classic Italian fare.

The bouquet is rich and expansive, well-structured with lots of black cherry, spices, cocoa and sage. The grapes were harvested from our estate vineyards in Redwood Valley and aged on French oak. Enjoy this lush and full-bodied wine with Mediterranean cuisine or roasted vegetables drizzled with olive oil and parmesan.

PINOT NOIR 2007 Mendocino

Light and delicate, this Pinot Noir is a harmonious symphony of strawberries, mint and pomegranate. The fruit is a blend of Uncle Bob's 28 year old dry farmed vineyard and 12 year old vines from Frey's Potter Valley Vineyard. Harvested in Oct. 2007 and aged on French Oak. Complements fish, fowl, and fruit salads.

MERLOT 2007 Redwood Valley

Nearly opaque garnet violet color. Ripe plum and spice aromas follow through on a soft, buoyant entry to a dry-yet-fruity medium body with tangy apple, cocoa, and citrus custard notes. Finishes with a nice cinnamon and clove-accented fade. Pair with spicy pork dishes.

LATE HARVEST ZINFANDEL SWEET WINE 2007 Redwood Valley

An elegant dessert wine, possessing sweet and luscious jammy fruit flavors to savor with chocolate truffles or blueberry pie. Long, lingering fall days of 2007 allowed Mendocino County Zinfandel grapes to ripen to maximum sweetness late into the harvest, allowing us to once again make this rich, smooth wine. (We cannot make it if the weather forbids.) Enjoy with your favorite dessert or alone as your new favorite dessert! Bottle size is 375ml.
